



This is your baby sibling.


Baby is so beautiful!

Use the opposite page to color and draw a picture of your baby sibling.




Your little sibling is in the NICU. The NICU is a place where babies go if they need special care. It's a nice place that will help them feel better!







Friends are important.


They can cheer us up when we feel down. They listen to us when we have problems.

Talk with your friends about the baby and how you are feeling. Draw a picture of your friends.




When your baby sibling comes home, where will they sleep?







